On Dec. 28th, Fr. Bob had a conforence at Lambeth Palace with the Rev. John Indrew, resident chaplain to the Archbishop of Canterbury and who is in charge of the English part of the lates-Seabury Exchange Progrem, under which Fr. John and Fr. Boh are exchanging parishes this year. The Chaplain conducted Fr. Dob and his son, Robert, age 12, on a tour of the Palace, the London residence of the Irchbishop. Of most interest were the chapel, restored from the Ver bombings, the mrch-bishop's study, and a favorite pic-ture of mrchbishop Laud, which had been used as evidence against him in his trial and then split by the soldiers of Oliver Cromwell. Fr. Bob told the Chaplain about the courtesy and kindness extended to the Kens by the posse of St. John's, the Diocese, and the City of Lincoln.

On Jan. 10 and 11, the acting Vicar served on the staff of the Youth Conference at the Bishop's Hostel sponsored by the Student Christian Movement.
